23 This stipulation (the "Stipulation") is entered into by and between U.S. Securities and Exchange
24 Commission ("Commission") and Navellier & Associates Inc. ("Debtor," together with Commission, the
25 "Parties"), by and through their respective counsel, with respect to the following:

26 **RECITALS**

27 A. On December 5, 2025, the Commission filed a complaint (the "Complaint"),
28 initiating adversary case 25-05047-hlb, seeking a determination that a debt owed by Debtor to the

Commission is excepted from discharge under Sections 523(a)(2) and 1141(d)(6)(A) of the Bankruptcy Code.

B. On January 13, 2026, the Commission filed in the main bankruptcy case a motion to dismiss, or in the alternative, to convert to Chapter 7, Debtor's chapter 11 case (ECF No. 76, the "Motion to Dismiss").

C. The Motion to Dismiss has been briefed by the Parties, was originally scheduled for hearing on March 18, 2026, at 1:30 p.m., then continued to May 6, 2026, at 2:30 p.m. pursuant to a stipulation and order [ECF No. 103], and then continued to June 3, 2026, at 11:00 a.m. pursuant to a stipulation and order [ECF No. 112].

D. The Parties have engaged in preliminary discussions to try to consensually resolve their disputes, including the Motion to Dismiss and Complaint.

E. The Parties have agreed that further continuing the hearing on the Motion to Dismiss may help resolve and/or narrow issues that are in dispute.

NOW, THEREFORE, BASED ON THE FOREGOING RECITALS, THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE AND STIPULATE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Subject to approval by the Court, the hearing on the Motion to Dismiss is continued to July 8, 2026, at 10:30 a.m.
