DEBTOR’S APPLICATION FOR ENTRY OF AN ORDER: (I) AUTHORIZING DEBTOR TO EMPLOY AND RETAIN SSG ADVISORS, LLC AS INVESTMENT BANKER TO THE DEBTOR NUNC PRO TUNC TO THE PETITION DATE, (II) APPROVING THE TERMS OF THE ENGAGEMENT AGREEMENT, (III) MODIFYING CERTAIN TIME-KEEPING REQUIREMENTS; AND (IV) GRANTING RELATED RELIEF

The debtor and debtor in possession in the above-captioned case (the “Debtor”) hereby applies to the Court (this “Application”), pursuant to sections 327(a) and 328(a) of title 11 of the United States Code (the “Bankruptcy Code”), Rules 2014(a) and 2016 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the “Bankruptcy Rules”) and Rules 2014-1 and 2016-2(h) of the Local Rules of Bankruptcy Practice and Procedure of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the “Local Rules”), for the entry of an order, substantially in the form attached as **Exhibit A** (the “Proposed Order”) (i) authorizing them to employ and retain SSG Advisors, LLC (“SSG”), as investment banker *nunc pro tunc* to the Petition Date (as defined below) in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in that certain Engagement Agreement, dated as of August 21, 2025, (the “Engagement Agreement”), a copy of which is attached as **Exhibit B**; (ii) approving the terms of the Engagement Agreement, including the fee and expense structure and the indemnification, contribution, reimbursement and related provisions set forth therein, (iii) modifying certain information requirements of Local Rule 2016-2, and (iv) granting related relief. In support of this Application, the Debtor submits the declaration of Teresa C. Kohl (the “Kohl”

Declaration”), attached hereto as **Exhibit C**. In further support of the Application, the Debtor respectfully represents as follows:

Jurisdiction

1. The United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the “Court”) has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334 and the *Amended Standing Order of Reference from the United States District Court for the District of Delaware*, dated February 29, 2012. This matter is a core proceeding within the meaning of 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2), and the Debtor confirms its consent pursuant to Rule 9013-1(f) of the Local Rules of Bankruptcy Practice and Procedure of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the “Local Rules”) to the entry of a final order by the Court in connection with this Application to the extent that it is later determined that the Court, absent consent of the parties, cannot enter final orders or judgments in connection herewith consistent with Article III of the United States Constitution.

2. Venue is proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409.

3. The bases for the relief sought herein are sections 327(a) and 328(a) of the Bankruptcy Code, Bankruptcy Rules 2014(a) and 2016, and Local Rules 2014-1 and 2016-2(h).

Background

4. On September 10, 2025, (the “Petition Date”), the Debtor commenced with this Court a voluntary case under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code. The Debtor continues to operate its business and manage its property as debtor in possession pursuant to sections 1107(a) and 1108 of the Bankruptcy Code. No trustee, examiner, or statutory committee of creditors has been appointed in this chapter 11 case.

5. A more detailed description of the Debtor's business and operations, and the events leading to the commencement of this chapter 11 case, is provided in the *Declaration of Ron Thayer in Support of Debtor's Chapter 11 Petitions and First Day Motions* (the "First Day Declaration").

Relief Requested

6. By this Application, pursuant to sections 327(a) and 328(a) of the Bankruptcy Code, Bankruptcy Rules 2014(a) and 2016, and Local Rules 2014-1 and 2016-2(h), the Debtor requests authority to appoint and retain SSG as its investment banker in the Debtor's chapter 11 case in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the Engagement Agreement, effective as of the Petition Date.

7. The Debtor intends to engage in a marketing and sale process regarding the disposition of the Debtor's business as a going concern.

SSG's Qualifications

8. In light of the size and complexity of this case, the Debtor requires a qualified and experienced investment banker with the resources, capabilities, and experience of SSG to assist them in pursuing the transactions that are crucial to the success of the Debtor's case. Investment banking expertise, such as the expertise provided by SSG, is a necessary, vital, and critical service that will complement the services provided by the Debtor's other professionals, without duplication. The Debtor believes the retention of SSG as its investment banker is in the best interest of its estate and will inure to the benefit of all parties in interest because, among other things, SSG has extensive experience in, and an excellent reputation for, providing investment banking services to debtors in bankruptcy reorganizations and other restructurings and has provided services to the Debtor prior to the Petition Date.

9. SSG is an internationally recognized investment banking firm. Since its founding in 2001, SSG has completed over 450 investment banking assignments. SSG's professionals have expertise in mergers and acquisitions, private placements, financial restructurings, valuations, and financial advisory services. Moreover, SSG has substantial expertise advising troubled companies, including in connection with distressed sales. The partners and associates of SSG have considerable expertise in the fields of bankruptcy, insolvency, reorganizations, liquidations, valuation, and debt restructuring, among other expertise.

10. 11. Additionally, SSG is already familiar with the Debtor's operations and assets. As discussed more fully in the Kohl Declaration, the Debtor first engaged SSG in August 2025. Since that date, SSG has worked with the Debtor, and the Debtor's other professionals, to provide the services outlined below. Thus, SSG is already knowledgeable about the Debtor's business and is well-suited to provide the investment banking services to the Debtor that are contemplated by the Engagement Agreement and described herein.

Services to Be Provided

12. Subject to the approval of the Court, the contemplated terms and conditions of SSG's engagement in this case are set forth in the Engagement Agreement, dated as of August 21, 2025. These terms were negotiated at arm's length between the Debtor and SSG and reflect the parties' mutual agreement as to the substantial efforts that will be required by SSG in this engagement. In consideration for the compensation contemplated in the Engagement Agreement, SSG has provided and has agreed to provide the following services (the "Services") in this case:

- Advise the Company on, and assist the Company in the preparation of, an information memorandum describing the Company and its management and financial status for use in discussions with prospective purchasers and assist in the due diligence process for a potential Sale;
- Assist the Company in developing a list of suitable potential buyers who will be contacted on a discreet and confidential basis after approval by the Company;
- Coordinate the execution of confidentiality agreements for potential buyers wishing to review the information memorandum;
- Assist the Company in coordinating management calls and (where appropriate) site visits for interested buyers and work with the management team to develop appropriate presentations for such calls and visits;
- Solicit competitive offers from potential buyers;
- Advise and assist the Company in structuring the Sale, negotiating the Sale agreements with potential buyers and evaluating the proposals from potential buyers, including, without limitation, advising and negotiating with respect to Sale structures;

13. SSG shall assist the Company in the negotiation with various stakeholders in the Company (the "Existing Stakeholders"), including, but not limited to any of the Company's shareholders, lenders, landlords, and general unsecured creditors in regard to a possible Restructuring of existing claims and equity as well as corporate governance. To the extent the Debtor requests SSG to perform additional services not contemplated by the Engagement Agreement, such services and the fees for such services will be mutually agreed upon by SSG and the Debtor, in writing, in advance and subject to Court approval.

14. The Services being provided to the Debtor are necessary to assist the Debtor in determining the most optimal and value-maximizing strategy in this chapter 11 case. The resources, capabilities, and experience of SSG in advising the Debtor are important to the Debtor's chapter 11 efforts. As a highly-qualified investment banking firm, SSG fulfills a critical need, which complements the services offered by the Debtor's other restructuring professionals.

Professional Compensation

15. In consideration of the Services, and as more fully described in the Engagement Agreement, subject to the Court's approval, the Debtor has agreed to pay SSG the proposed compensation (the "Professional Fees and Expenses") set forth in the Engagement Agreement, which is summarized below:²

- Initial Fee. An initial fee (the "Initial Fee") equal to \$50,000 due upon signing the Engagement Agreement. The Initial Fee applies to the first month of the Engagement Term (as such term is hereafter defined);
- Monthly Fees. Monthly fees (the "Monthly Fees") of \$50,000 per month payable beginning in the second month of the Engagement Term, on September 21, 2025 and on the twenty-first (21st) day of each month thereafter throughout the Engagement Term. The Monthly Fee for the month in which the Company files one or more Bankruptcy Cases shall be payable prior to filing.
- Transaction Fee. Upon the consummation of a Sale and/or Restructuring to or with any party, SSG shall be entitled to a fee (the "Transaction Fee"), payable in cash, in federal funds via wire transfer or certified check, at and as a condition of closing such Sale and/or Restructuring and as a direct carveout from proceeds and cash, prior in right to any pre- and post-petition secured debt, equal to the following:
 - a) In the event that a stalking horse purchaser is identified by the Company and its stakeholders prior to SSG's engagement herein, or in the event of a credit bid by the secured creditors, or any of them, without a qualified overbid, then SSG's Transaction Fee shall be \$450,000 and, in that event, SSG's fees shall be capped at \$600,000, inclusive of the Initial Fee, Monthly Fees and Transaction Fee.
 - b) In the event that a qualified overbid is received topping the stalking horse bid and/or credit bid, then SSG's Transaction Fee shall be the greater of (i) \$750,000 or (ii) two (2) percent of Total Consideration (as such term is hereafter defined).
 - c) In the event of a Restructuring with existing stakeholders, SSG's Transaction Fee shall be \$450,000 and, in that event, SSG's fees shall be capped at \$600,000, inclusive of the Initial Fee, Monthly Fees and Transaction Fee.

- For the avoidance of doubt, SSG shall only be paid one Transaction Fee, whichever is greater. Further, the cap on fees shall apply regardless of the duration of the Sale and/or Restructuring process.

16. SSG's strategic and financial expertise as well as its capital markets knowledge, financing skills, restructuring capabilities and mergers and acquisitions expertise, some or all of which may be required by the Debtor during the term of SSG's engagement hereunder, were important factors in determining the Fee and Expense Structure. The Debtor believes that the ultimate benefit of SSG's services hereunder cannot be measured by reference to the number of hours to be expended by SSG's professionals in the performance of such services.

17. SSG has not shared or agreed to share any compensation to be paid by the Debtor with any other person, other than other principals and employees of SSG, in accordance with section 504 of the Bankruptcy Code.

18. In sum, in light of the foregoing and given the numerous issues which SSG may be required to address in the performance of its services hereunder, SSG's commitment to the variable level of time and effort necessary to address all such issues as they arise, and the market prices for SSG's services for engagements of this nature both out-of-court and in a chapter 11 context, the Debtor believes that the Fee and Expense Structure is market-based and fair and reasonable under the standards set forth in section 328(a) of the Bankruptcy Code.

19. Accordingly, as more fully described below, the Debtor believes that this Court should approve SSG's retention subject to the standard of review set forth in section 328(a) of the Bankruptcy Code, and that SSG's compensation should not be subject to any additional standard of review under section 330 of the Bankruptcy Code or otherwise.

Indemnification

20. As part of the overall compensation payable to SSG under the terms of the Engagement Agreement, the Debtor has agreed to certain indemnification and contribution obligations as described in the Engagement Agreement and “Attachment A” attached thereto (the “Indemnification Provision”). The Indemnification Provision provides, among other things, that the Debtor will indemnify and hold harmless SSG and its affiliates and their respective past, present and future directors, officers, shareholders, partners, members, employees, agents, representatives, advisors, subcontractors and controlling persons (collectively the “Indemnified Parties”), to the fullest extent lawful, from and against any and all claims, losses, damages, expenses or liabilities, joint or several, arising out of or related to the Engagement Agreement, subject to customary carve outs for gross negligence, bad faith, or intentional misconduct of SSG. Both the Debtor and SSG believe that such provisions are customary and reasonable for investment banking engagements, both out-of-court and in chapter 11 case. The terms of the Indemnification Provision are similar to indemnification terms that have been previously approved by the Court and other bankruptcy courts in other large chapter 11 cases.

21. The Debtor and SSG fully negotiated the terms of the Engagement Agreement and the Indemnification Provision at arm’s length, and the Debtor respectfully submits that the terms of the Indemnification Provision are reasonable, market based, and in the best interests of the Debtor, its estate, and creditors. Accordingly, as part of this Application, the Debtor requests that this Court approve the terms of the Engagement Agreement and Attachment “A” attached thereto.

No Duplication of Services

22. In addition to this Application, the Debtor has applied, or anticipate that they will apply, to the Court to retain, among others, (a) Gellert Seitz Busenkell & Brown, LLC, as

bankruptcy counsel, (b) Carl Marks Advisory Group LLC, as restructuring advisors and Chief Restructuring Officer; and (c) Stretto, Inc., as claims and noticing agent. The Debtor is mindful of the need to avoid duplication of services and the Debtor understands that SSG will use its reasonable efforts to work cooperatively with the Debtor's other professionals to integrate any respective work performed by those professionals on behalf of the Debtor. The Debtor believes that SSG's services will not duplicate the efforts of the other professionals retained by the Debtor in this case.

Record-Keeping Requirements and Modification of Local Rule 2016-2

23. It is not the general practice of investment banking firms, including SSG, to keep detailed time records similar to those customarily kept by attorneys and required by Local Rule 2016-2(d). Because SSG does not ordinarily maintain contemporaneous time records in one-tenth hour (.10) increments or provide or conform to a schedule of hourly rates for its professionals, the Debtor requests pursuant to Local Rule 2016-2(h) that SSG be excused from compliance with the requirements under Local Rule 2016-2(d). Instead, notwithstanding that SSG does not charge for its services on an hourly basis, SSG proposes to maintain records of services rendered for the Debtor, including summary descriptions of those services, the approximate time expended in providing those services (in half-hour (0.50) increments) and the identity of the individuals who provided those services. SSG will present such records together with its final and sole fee application filed with the Court.

24. SSG will also maintain detailed records of any actual and necessary costs and expenses incurred in connection with the aforementioned services, including, without limitation, the fees and expenses of SSG's legal counsel. SSG's application for compensation and expenses

will be paid by the Debtor, pursuant to the terms of the Engagement Agreement, in accordance with the procedures established by the Court.

25. Bankruptcy courts in this and other jurisdictions have approved similar waivers to the one requested in this Application. *See, e.g., In re M&G USA Corp.*, Case No. 17-12307 (BLS) (Bankr. D. Del. Dec. 1, 2017); *In re GenOn Energy, Inc.*, No. 17-33695 (DRJ) (Bankr. S.D. Tex, July 14, 2017); *In re rue21, inc.*, No. 17-22045 (GLT) (Bankr. W.D. Pa. June 28, 2017); *In re Answers Holdings, Inc.*, No. 17-10496 (SMB) (Bankr. S.D.N.Y. Apr. 7, 2017); *In re Ultra Petroleum Corp.*, No. 16-32202 (MI) (Bankr. S.D. Tex. June 20, 2016); *In re Sports Auth. Holdings, Inc.*, No. 16-10527 (MFW) (Bankr. D. Del. Mar. 29, 2016).

Disinterestedness

26. As more fully set forth in the Kohl Declaration, prior to filing this Application, the Debtor's counsel provided SSG with a list of Potential Parties in Interest, which is the same list the Debtor's counsel used to search for potential conflicts in connection with its retention application. SSG ran the list of Potential Parties in Interest through its database and also sent an email to all SSG personnel to determine if SSG had any connections with the Potential Parties in Interest.

27. To the best of the Debtor's knowledge, information and belief as of the date hereof, SSG (a) is a "disinterested person," as such term is defined in section 101(14) of the Bankruptcy Code and as required under section 327(a) of the Bankruptcy Code and, as set forth in further detail in the Kohl Declaration, (b) does not hold or represent an interest materially adverse to Debtor's estates and (c) has no connection to the Debtor, its creditors, shareholders or other parties in interest, except as disclosed in the Kohl Declaration.

28. During the 90-day period before the Petition Date, SSG received \$50,000.00 as its Initial Fee.

Basis for Relief

**A. The Debtor Should Be Permitted to Employ and Retain SSG
on the Terms of the Engagement Agreement Pursuant to
Sections 327 and 328 of the Bankruptcy Code**

29. The Debtor seeks approval of SSG's retention and compensation structure pursuant to sections 327(a) and 328(a) of the Bankruptcy Code. Section 327(a) of the Bankruptcy Code provides, in relevant part, as follows:

Except as otherwise provided in this section, the [Debtor], with the court's approval, may employ one or more attorneys, accountants, appraisers, auctioneers, or other professional persons, that do not hold or represent an interest adverse to the estate, and that are disinterested persons, to represent or assist the [Debtor] in carrying out [their] duties under this title.

11 U.S.C. § 327(a).

30. Section 1107(b) of the Bankruptcy Code elaborates upon sections 101(14) and 327(a) of the Bankruptcy Code in cases under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code and provides that "a person is not disqualified for employment under section 327 of [the Bankruptcy Code] by a debtor in possession solely because of such person's employment by or representation of the debtor before the commencement of the case." 11 U.S.C. § 1107(b).

31. Section 328(a) of the Bankruptcy Code provides, in pertinent part, that a debtor "with the court's approval, may employ or authorize the employment of a professional person under section 327 . . . on any reasonable terms and conditions of employment, including on a retainer, on an hourly basis, on a fixed or percentage fee basis, or on a contingent fee basis." 11 U.S.C. § 328(a). Thus, section 328(a) of the Bankruptcy Code permits the compensation of professionals, including financial advisors and investment banking firms, on more flexible terms that reflect the nature of their services and market conditions.

32. As discussed above and as set forth in the Kohl Declaration, SSG satisfies the disinterestedness standard in section 327(a) of the Bankruptcy Code. Additionally, given the numerous issues that SSG may be required to address in the performance of the services for the Debtor pursuant to the Engagement Agreement, SSG's commitment to the variable level of time and effort necessary to address all such issues as they arise and the market prices for SSG's services for engagements of this nature, the Debtor believes that the terms and conditions of the Engagement Agreement are fair, reasonable and market-based under the standards set forth in section 328(a) of the Bankruptcy Code.

33. Similar fixed and contingency fee arrangements have been approved and implemented by courts in this and other districts in other large chapter 11 cases. *See, e.g., In re Cloud Peak Energy Inc.*, Case No. 19-11047 (KG) (Bankr. B. Nunc Pro Tunc Relief is Warranted

34. The Debtor believes that the employment of SSG *nunc pro tunc* to the Petition Date is warranted under the circumstances of this case so SSG may be compensated for its services prior to entry of an order approving SSG's retention. Further, the Debtor believes no party in interest will be prejudiced by the granting of the *nunc pro tunc* employment because SSG has provided, and will continue to provide, valuable services to the Debtor's estate in the interim period.

35. Courts in this and other districts routinely approve *nunc pro tunc* employment similar to that requested herein. *See, e.g., In re Cloud Peak Energy Inc.*, Case No. 19-11047 (KG) (Bankr. D. Del. June 12, 2019); *In re M&G USA Corp.*, Case No. 17-12307 (BLS) (Bankr. D. Del. Dec. 1, 2017); *In re GenOn Energy, Inc.*, No. 17-33695 (DRJ) (Bankr. S.D. Tex. July 14, 2017); *In re rue21, Inc.*, No. 17-22045 (GLT) (Bankr. W.D. Pa. June 28, 2017); *In re Answers Holdings, Inc.*, No. 17-10496 (SMB) (Bankr. S.D.N.Y. Apr. 7, 2017); *In re Ultra Petroleum Corp.*, No. 16-32202 (MI) (Bankr. S.D. Tex. June 20, 2016); *In re Sports Auth. Holdings, Inc.*, No. 16-10527 (MFW) (Bankr. D. Del. Mar. 29, 2016).

C. The Retention of SSG is Critical to the Debtor's Chapter 11 Efforts

36. The Debtor submits that the retention of SSG is in the best interest of all parties in interest in this case. SSG is a pre-eminent financial advisory and investment banking firm that is already familiar with the Debtor's business. Denial of the relief requested herein will deprive the Debtor of the assistance of a uniquely qualified investment banking advisor and would be disadvantageous to the Debtor and all parties in interest. The Debtor remains in need of investment banking services to perform analysis, engage the marketplace, and negotiate the terms of one or more potential transactions in an effort to pursue the most value-maximizing strategy in this case. Absent SSG's retention, the Debtor would likely be required to engage a new investment banker

who would lack SSG's understanding of the Debtor's business. A newly retained investment banking advisor would require time and resources to get up to speed, which would imperil the Debtor's ability to efficiently determine and execute the appropriate strategy in this case and create attendant administrative costs for the Debtor's estate.

37. Moreover, comparable investment bankers that the Debtor would require in this case would likely charge an equal or greater amount of fees. Based on services performed to date, SSG has been integral to preparing the Debtor for this case. Based on the foregoing, the Debtor submits it has satisfied the requirements of the Bankruptcy Code, the Bankruptcy Rules, and the Local Rules to support entry of an order authorizing the Debtor to retain and employ SSG in this case on the terms described herein and in the Engagement Agreement.

Notice

38. Notice of this Application will be provided to the following parties, or, in lieu thereof, their counsel, if known: (a) the Office of the United States Trustee; (b) the Debtor's twenty (20) largest unsecured creditors; (c) Wells Fargo, National Association; and (d) any party that has requested notice pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 2002 (collectively, the "Notice Parties"). The Debtor submits that no other or further notice need be provided.

No Prior Request

39. No prior request for the relief sought herein has been made to this Court or any other court.

WHEREFORE, the Debtor respectfully requests that the Court enter the Proposed Order and grant such other and further relief as may be appropriate.

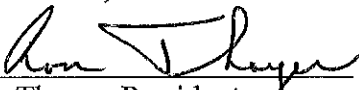

ORDER: (I) AUTHORIZING DEBTOR TO EMPLOY AND RETAIN SSG ADVISORS, LLC AS INVESTMENT BANKER TO THE DEBTOR *NUNC PRO TUNC* TO THE PETITION DATE, (II) APPROVING THE TERMS OF THE ENGAGEMENT AGREEMENT, (III) MODIFYING CERTAIN TIME-KEEPING REQUIREMENTS, AND (IV) GRANTING RELATED RELIEF

Upon consideration of the application (the “Application”)² filed by the debtor and debtor in possession in the above-captioned cases (the “Debtor”), pursuant to sections 327(a) and 328(a) of title 11 of the United States Code (the “Bankruptcy Code”), Rules 2014(a) and 2016 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the “Bankruptcy Rules”) and Rules 2014-1 and 2016-2(h) of the Local Rules of Bankruptcy Practice and Procedure of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the “Local Rules”), for the entry of an order (the “Order”) (i) authorizing the Debtor to employ and retain SSG Advisors, LLC (“SSG”), as investment banker *nunc pro tunc* to the Petition Date in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in that certain Engagement Agreement, dated as of August 21, 2025 (the “Engagement Agreement”); (ii) approving the terms of the Engagement Agreement, including the fee and expense structure and the indemnification, contribution, reimbursement and related provisions set forth therein, (iii) modifying certain information requirements of Local Rule 2016-2, and (iv) granting related relief, as more fully set forth in the Application; and upon consideration of the Kohl Declaration, attached

to the Application as **Exhibit C**; this Court has found that: (i) this Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334 and the *Amended Standing Order of Reference* from the United States District Court for the District of Delaware, dated February 29, 2012, (ii) this Court is able to issue a final order consistent with Article III of the United States Constitution, (iii) venue is proper in this district pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409, (iv) this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b), and (v) notice of the Application and a hearing on the Application was sufficient under the circumstances, and it appearing that no other or further notice need be provided; and after due deliberation, this Court has determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Application establish just cause for the relief granted herein and that the terms and conditions of SSG's engagement, including but not limited to the fee and expense structure set forth in the Engagement Agreement and summarized in the Application, are reasonable as required by section 328(a) of the Bankruptcy Code; and the Court having found that SSG is a "disinterested person" as that term is defined in section 101(14) of the Bankruptcy Code; and the Court having found that the relief requested in the Application is in the best interests of the Debtor, its creditors, its estate and all other parties in interest; and sufficient cause appearing therefore; it is HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Application is GRANTED as set forth herein.
2. The Debtor is hereby authorized, pursuant to sections 327 and 328(a) of the Bankruptcy Code, Bankruptcy Rule 2014 and Local Rule 2014-1, to employ and retain SSG as their investment banker in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the Engagement Agreement, *nunc pro tunc* to the Petition Date and to pay fees and reimburse expenses to SSG on the terms and at the times specified in the Engagement Agreement, subject to the modifications set forth herein.

3. The terms of the Engagement Agreement are approved in all respects except as limited or modified herein.

4. All of SSG's compensation set forth in the Engagement Agreement, including, without limitation, the Fee and Expense Structure, is approved pursuant to section 328(a) of the Bankruptcy Code and SSG shall be compensated and reimbursed pursuant to section 328(a) of the Bankruptcy Code in accordance with the terms of the Engagement Agreement, subject to the procedures set forth in the Bankruptcy Code, the Bankruptcy Rules, the Local Rules and any other applicable orders of the Court.

5. None of the fees payable to SSG shall constitute a "bonus" or fee enhancement under applicable law.

6. SSG will submit monthly fee invoices to the Office of the United States Trustee for the District of Delaware and any official committee of unsecured creditors describing in narrative fashion the work performed during the monthly period by each professional working on the engagement. For the avoidance of doubt, SSG shall be entitled to the payment of its Monthly Fee on the twenty-first (21st) of the month as provided by the Engagement Agreement while submitting the monthly fee invoice as described herein, without the need for monthly or interim applications for compensation, and the U.S. Trustee shall have review rights pursuant to section 330 of the Bankruptcy Code.

7. With respect to payment by the Debtor's estate of any Transaction Fee, and expense reimbursements, SSG shall file a final fee application for final allowance of compensation for services and reimbursement of expenses pursuant to the procedures set forth in sections 330 and 331 of the Bankruptcy Code, the Bankruptcy Rules, the Local Rules, and any applicable orders of this Court. For the avoidance of doubt, as set forth in the Engagement Agreement, SSG shall be

entitled to only one Transaction Fee. SSG's compensation shall be subject to the standard of review provided in section 328(a) of the Bankruptcy Code and not subject to any other standard of review under section 330 of the Bankruptcy Code, other than the U.S. Trustee's review as set forth above.

8. Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary in this Order, the U.S. Trustee shall have the right to object to SSG's request for final compensation based on the reasonableness standard provided in section 330 of the Bankruptcy Code, not section 328(a) of the Bankruptcy Code. This Order and the record relating to the Court's consideration of the Application shall not prejudice or otherwise affect the rights of the U.S. Trustee to challenge the reasonableness of SSG's fees under the standard set forth in the preceding sentence. Accordingly, nothing in this Order or the record shall constitute a finding of fact or conclusion of law binding the U.S. Trustee, on appeal or otherwise, with respect to the reasonableness of SSG's fees.

9. SSG is granted a waiver of the information requirements relating to compensation requests set forth in Local Rule 2016-2(d) to the extent requested in the Application. Among other things, SSG shall maintain only summary records of services rendered for the Debtor, including summary descriptions of those services, the approximate time expended in providing those services (in half-hour (0.50) increments) and the identity of the individuals who provided those services. SSG shall include such summary records in its fee applications.

10. The Debtor shall be bound by the indemnification, contribution, reimbursement, exculpation and other provisions of the Engagement Agreement and will indemnify and hold harmless SSG and the other Indemnified Parties (as defined in the Engagement Agreement), pursuant to the Engagement Agreement, subject, during the pendency of the cases, to the following:

- (a) SSG shall not be entitled to indemnification, contribution or reimbursement pursuant to the Engagement Agreement for services other than those services set forth in the Engagement Agreement, unless such additional services and the indemnification, contribution or reimbursement therefore are approved by this Court;
- (b) The Debtor shall have no obligation to indemnify the Indemnified Parties, or provide contribution or reimbursement to the Indemnified Parties, for any claim or expense that is either: (i) judicially determined (the determination having become final) to have arisen from such Indemnified Party's gross negligence, willful misconduct, breach of fiduciary duty, if any, bad faith or self-dealing; (ii) for a contractual dispute in which the Debtors alleges the breach of SSG's contractual obligations, unless the Court determines that indemnification, contribution or reimbursement would be permissible pursuant to *In re United Artists Theatre Co.*, 315 F.3d 217 (3d Cir. 2003); or (iii) settled prior to a judicial determination as to the exclusions set forth in clauses (i) and (ii) above, but determined by this Court, after notice and a hearing, to be a claim or expense for which SSG should not receive indemnity, contribution or reimbursement under the terms of the Engagement Agreement as modified by this Order; and
- (c) If, before the earlier of (i) the entry of an order confirming a chapter 11 plan in this Case (that order having become a final order no longer subject to appeal) and (ii) the entry of an order closing this Case, SSG believes that it is entitled to the payment of any amounts by the Debtor on account of the Debtor's indemnification, contribution and/or reimbursement obligations under the Engagement Agreement (as modified by this Order), including, without limitation, the advancement of defense costs, SSG must file an application therefore in this Court, and the Debtor may not pay any such amounts to SSG before the entry of an order by this Court approving such payment. This subparagraph (c) is intended only to specify the period of time under which this Court shall have jurisdiction over any request for fees and expenses by SSG for indemnification, contribution or reimbursement, and not a provision limiting the duration of the Debtor's obligation to indemnify the Indemnified Parties. All parties in interest shall retain the right to object to any demand by SSG for indemnification, contribution or reimbursement.

11. Notwithstanding any Bankruptcy Rule or Local Rule that might otherwise delay the effectiveness of this Order, the terms and conditions of this Order shall be effective and enforceable immediately upon its entry.

12. The relief granted herein shall be binding upon any chapter 11 trustee appointed in the cases or upon any chapter 7 trustee appointed in the event of a subsequent conversion of the cases to cases under chapter 7.

13. To the extent that there may be any inconsistency between the terms of the Application, the Kohl Declaration, the Engagement Agreement, and this Order, the terms of this Order shall govern.

14. The Debtor is hereby authorized to take such actions and to execute such documents as may be necessary to implement the relief granted by this Order.

15. This Court shall retain jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the implementation and/or interpretation of this Order.

Dear Mr. Thayer:

This agreement ("Engagement Agreement") will serve as the contract between US Magnesium LLC ("USM" or the "Company") and SSG Advisors, LLC ("SSG") regarding the retention of SSG as exclusive investment banker to USM for the purposes outlined in this Engagement Agreement. SSG's responsibilities hereunder involve providing investment banking services to the Company, on an exclusive basis, focusing on (i) a Sale, and/or (ii) a Restructuring (collectively "Transaction", as further defined below).

A. SSG's Role:

1. Sale Services

- Advise the Company on, and assist the Company in the preparation of, an information memorandum describing the Company and its management and financial status for use in discussions with prospective purchasers and assist in the due diligence process for a potential Sale;
- Assist the Company in developing a list of suitable potential buyers who will be contacted on a discreet and confidential basis after approval by the Company;
- Coordinate the execution of confidentiality agreements for potential buyers wishing to review the information memorandum;
- Assist the Company in coordinating management calls and (where appropriate) site visits for interested buyers and work with the management team to develop appropriate presentations for such calls and visits;
- Solicit competitive offers from potential buyers;
- Advise and assist the Company in structuring the Sale, negotiating the Sale agreements with potential buyers and evaluating the proposals from potential buyers, including, without limitation, advising and negotiating with respect to Sale structures;

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- Provide testimony in support of the Sale, as necessary;
- Otherwise assist the Company, its attorneys and advisors, as necessary, through closing on a best efforts basis.

2. Restructuring Services

- SSG shall assist the Company in the negotiation with various stakeholders in the Company (the "Existing Stakeholders"), including, but not limited to any of the Company's shareholders, lenders, landlords, and general unsecured creditors in regard to a possible Restructuring of existing claims and equity as well as corporate governance.

In performing the services described above, the Company will furnish or cause to be furnished to SSG such reasonable and customary information as SSG reasonably believes appropriate to the execution of its engagement hereunder (all such information so furnished being the "Information"). The Company represents to SSG that all Information furnished by it or its agents will be complete and correct in all material respects, to the best of its knowledge, and that until the expiration of SSG's engagement hereunder, it will advise SSG promptly of the occurrence of any event or any other change known by it or its agents that results in the Information ceasing to be complete and correct in all material respects. The Company recognizes and confirms that SSG: (a) will use and rely primarily on the Information and on information available from generally recognized public sources in performing the services contemplated hereby without having independently verified any of the same; (b) does not assume responsibility for accurateness or completeness of the Information and such other information; and (c) will not make an appraisal of any of the assets or liabilities of the Company. For the purposes of this Engagement Agreement, "known to," "to the knowledge of" or similar phrases means the actual knowledge, after due inquiry, of the executive officers of USM.

The Company agrees that SSG shall be its exclusive investment banker in connection with any Sale and/or Restructuring undertaken with a prospective purchaser, investor or lender with respect to the Company during the Engagement Term, as defined below, of this Engagement Agreement. The Company agrees that, during the Engagement Term, SSG shall assist and advise the Company in its negotiations with all such prospective purchasers, investors, and lenders in connection with any Sale, and/or Restructuring. In that regard, the Company agrees to identify to SSG: (a) all prospective purchasers and investors who have been in contact with the Company prior to the date hereof and (b) all prospective purchasers and investors who come in contact with the Company during the Engagement Term.

SSG will consult with and advise the Company with respect to the financial aspects of any proposed Sale and/or Restructuring including price, terms, and conditions of a Sale and/or a Restructuring. SSG will not, however, have any authority to bind the Company with respect to any proposed Sale and/or Restructuring. Likewise, nothing contained herein shall require the Company to accept the terms of any proposal and the Company shall at all times have the right in its sole and absolute discretion to reject any proposed Sale and/or Restructuring regardless of the terms proposed.

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B. **SSG's Compensation**

As compensation for providing the foregoing services, SSG shall receive the following:

1. **Initial Fee.** An initial fee (the "Initial Fee") equal to \$50,000 due upon signing this Engagement Agreement. The Initial Fee applies to the first month of the Engagement Term (as such term is hereafter defined);
2. **Monthly Fees.** Monthly fees (the "Monthly Fees") of \$50,000 per month payable beginning in the second month of the Engagement Term, on September 21, 2025 and on the twenty-first (21st) day of each month thereafter throughout the Engagement Term. The Monthly Fee for the month in which the Company files one or more Bankruptcy Cases shall be payable prior to filing.
3. **Transaction Fee.** Upon the consummation of a Sale and/or Restructuring to or with any party, SSG shall be entitled to a fee (the "Transaction Fee"), payable in cash, in federal funds via wire transfer or certified check, at and as a condition of closing such Sale and/or Restructuring and as a direct carveout from proceeds and cash, prior in right to any pre- and post-petition secured debt, equal to the following:
 - (a) In the event that a stalking horse purchaser is identified by the Company and its stakeholders prior to SSG's engagement herein, or in the event of a credit bid by the secured creditors, or any of them, without a qualified overbid, then SSG's Transaction Fee shall be \$450,000 and, in that event, SSG's fees shall be capped at \$600,000, inclusive of the Initial Fee, Monthly Fees and Transaction Fee.
 - (b) In the event that a qualified overbid is received topping the stalking horse bid and/or credit bid, then SSG's Transaction Fee shall be the greater of (i) \$750,000 or (ii) two (2) percent of Total Consideration (as such term is hereafter defined).
 - (c) In the event of a Restructuring with existing stakeholders, SSG's Transaction Fee shall be \$450,000 and, in that event, SSG's fees shall be capped at \$600,000, inclusive of the Initial Fee, Monthly Fees and Transaction Fee.

For the avoidance of doubt, SSG shall only be paid one Transaction Fee, whichever is greater. Further, the cap on fees shall apply regardless of the duration of the Sale and/or Restructuring process.

4. In addition to the foregoing Initial Fee, Monthly Fee and Transaction Fee noted above whether or not a Sale and/or a Restructuring is consummated, SSG will be entitled to reimbursement for all of SSG's reasonable and documented out-of-pocket expenses incurred in connection with the subject matter of this Engagement Agreement; provided that any invoice including reimbursable expenses will be supported by customary documentation sufficient to show the date, payee, purpose and amount of the expense. For the purposes of this Section B.4, expenses incurred relating to an electronic data room, not to

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exceed \$2,500 in any month, shall be deemed to have been approved in advance by the Company.

C. **Definitions**

For the purpose of this Engagement Agreement:

Total Consideration shall mean the gross purchase price paid at the closing of the Sale for the equity, assets, or any portion of either, plus the assumption or payoff of indebtedness (secured and unsecured) of the Company.

For purposes of computing any fees payable to SSG hereunder, non-cash consideration shall be valued as follows: (a) publicly traded securities shall be valued in the manner specified in the definitive agreement for the Sale, or, if not so specified, at the average of their closing prices (as reported in The Wall Street Journal) for the five (5) trading days prior to the closing of the Sale; and (b) any other non-cash consideration shall be valued at the fair market value thereof as determined in good faith by the Company and SSG. If such aggregate consideration may be increased by contingent payments such as an "earnout" or other monetary agreement in the transaction, the portion of SSG's fee relating thereto shall be calculated and paid when and as such contingent payments or other monetary amounts are received.

Transaction shall mean a Sale or transfer, directly or indirectly, of all or substantially all, of the assets or equity of USM to any party and/or Restructuring involving the reorganization of the Company's balance sheet.

D. **Term of Engagement**

This Engagement Agreement shall remain in force (the "Engagement Term") for a period of four (4) months from the date of signing this Engagement Agreement and may be extended thereafter upon prior written consent of the parties. Either party may terminate this Engagement Agreement upon thirty (30) days prior written notice to the other; provided, however, that this Engagement Agreement shall automatically terminate immediately upon the closing of a Sale and/or a Restructuring. Upon the termination of this Engagement Agreement, neither party shall have any further obligations to the other except that: (a) termination of the Engagement Agreement shall not affect SSG's right to indemnification under the Indemnification paragraph below; (b) the Company shall remain obligated to pay SSG any unpaid Monthly Fees and to reimburse SSG for any expenses incurred in accordance with this Agreement through the date of the termination of the Engagement Agreement; and (c) if a Sale and/or a Restructuring is consummated within twelve (12) months ("Trailer Term") of the termination of this Engagement Agreement with a party with whom SSG had meaningful contact during the Engagement Term, the Company shall remain obligated to pay a Transaction Fee, as calculated above; *provided*, however, that if this Engagement Agreement has been terminated for gross negligence, bad faith, actual fraud, or willful misconduct by SSG in the performance of SSG's duties under this Engagement Agreement, the Company shall have no further obligations to pay any additional fees. Sections B, D, E, F and G (entitled Compensation, Term of Engagement, Indemnification, Miscellaneous, and Scope of SSG's Duties, respectively) of this Engagement Agreement shall survive the expiration or termination of this Engagement Agreement indefinitely.

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E. **Indemnification**

The Company hereby acknowledges and agrees to the indemnification arrangements between the parties hereto as described on Attachment A hereto, which Attachment is incorporated herein and forms an integral part hereof.

F. **Miscellaneous**

No fee payable to any other financial advisor or finder by the Company in connection with the subject matter of this Engagement Agreement shall reduce or otherwise affect any fee payable to SSG hereunder. This Engagement Agreement sets forth the entire understanding of the parties relating to the subject matter hereof and supersedes and cancels any prior communications, understandings and agreements between the parties hereto. This Engagement Agreement cannot be modified or changed, nor can any of its provisions be waived, except by written agreement signed by both parties. The benefits of this Engagement Agreement shall inure to the respective successors and assigns of the parties hereto and of the Indemnified Parties and their respective successors, assigns and representatives, and the obligations and liabilities assumed in this Engagement Agreement by the parties hereto shall be binding upon their respective successors and assigns.

This Engagement Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, which counterparts, taken together, shall constitute one and the same Engagement Agreement.

G. **Scope of Duties**

The Company hereby acknowledges and agrees that: (a) it has retained SSG for the purposes set forth in the Engagement Agreement and that the rights and obligations of the parties hereto are contractual in nature, and (b) SSG has not made any warranties or guarantees of any nature with respect to the success or satisfactory conclusion of any Sale and/or Restructuring or as to the economic, financial or other results which may be obtained or experienced by the Company as a result thereof.

H. **Bankruptcy Court Proceedings**

In the event the Company files one or more Bankruptcy Cases during the Engagement Term, the Company shall use its commercially reasonable efforts to have SSG employed upon the same or substantially similar terms and to have this Engagement Agreement and SSG's retention as the Company's exclusive investment banker approved by a Court of competent jurisdiction. The Company cannot, and does not, guarantee a successful outcome for such efforts.

I. **Other Matters**

SSG has the right, following a Sale and/or a Restructuring closing, to place advertisements in financial and other newspapers and journals and to send email advertising at its own expense describing its services to the Company hereunder, provided such advertising is limited to customary published notices (e.g., a "tombstone" ad).

In accordance with the requirements of the USA Patriot Act (Title III of Pub. L. 107-56 (signed into law October 26, 2001)), SSG is required to obtain, verify and record

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information that identifies its clients, which information may include the name and address of the Company, and its senior management team as well as other information that will allow SSG to properly identify its clients. Additionally, SSG maintains important disclosures on its web site www.ssgca.com. These disclosures may be updated periodically on an as-needed basis. The Company agrees to accept and receive all of these disclosures by electronically accessing the website referenced above and acknowledges that printed hard copies of these disclosures are available upon request by contacting SSG directly at (610) 940-1094.

J. **Securities Platform**

All transactions involving the sale or purchase of any security (as defined by the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 or the rules and regulations promulgated there under) are offered through SSG Capital Advisors, LLC. ("SCA") which is an affiliated registered Broker-Dealer in good standing with the Financial Industry Regulatory Authority ("FINRA") and the Securities Investor Protection Corporation ("SIPC"). Principals of SSG are registered representatives of SCA. Therefore, SCA is included collectively as "SSG" with all the rights and obligations thereto under the terms of this Engagement Agreement.

To the extent a Transaction Fee is payable to SSG in connection with a Sale constituting the purchase or sale of any security (as defined by the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 or the rules and regulations promulgated there under), such Transaction Fee (excluding the Initial Fee and Monthly Fees) shall be specifically paid to SCA. In addition to the Initial Fee and Monthly Fees, under no circumstances will the Company be obligated to pay any fees in an aggregate amount in excess of the Transaction Fee. Payment of the fee to SCA shall constitute and be deemed payment of the Transaction Fee under the Engagement Agreement.

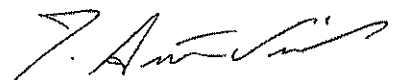

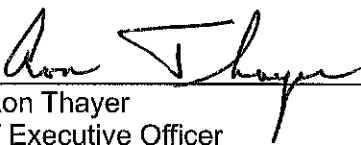

**DECLARATION OF TERESA C. KOHL IN SUPPORT OF DEBTOR’S APPLICATION

REQUIREMENTS; AND (IV) GRANTING RELATED RELIEF**

I, Teresa C. Kohl, hereby declare that the following is true and correct to the best of my knowledge, information, and belief:

1. I am a Managing Director of SSG Advisors, LLC (“**SSG**”), an investment banking firm that maintains offices at 300 Barr Harbor Drive, Suite 420, West Conshohocken, PA 19428, and I am duly authorized to make this declaration (the “**Declaration**”) on behalf of SSG. I have over 28 years of experience in the restructuring industry and extensive experience: (a) marketing companies or their assets for sale, including companies in distress and debtors in bankruptcy cases; (b) raising capital for special situation transactions; and (c) restructuring companies’ balance sheets both in and out of court.

2. This Declaration is submitted in support of the *Debtor’s Application for Entry of an Order (I) Authorizing Them to Employ and Retain SSG Advisors, LLC as Investment Banker to the Debtor Nunc Pro Tunc to the Petition Date, (II) Approving the Terms of the Engagement*

Agreement, (III) Waiving Certain Time-Keeping Requirements, and (IV) Granting Related Relief (the “**Application**”).²

3. Except as otherwise stated herein, I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth herein and, if called as a witness, I could and would testify competently thereto. To the extent any information disclosed herein requires amendment or modification upon SSG’s completion of further review or as additional party in interest information becomes available to it, a supplemental declaration will be submitted to the Court reflecting such amended or modified information.

SSG’S QUALIFICATIONS

6. Through its prepetition representation of the Debtor, SSG has gained substantial knowledge regarding the Debtor's business and the various legal issues likely to arise in this chapter 11 case. Accordingly, SSG is well-suited to provide the investment banking services to the Debtor that are contemplated by the Engagement Agreement and described herein.

SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED

7. Subject to the Court's approval, SSG will provide the following services (the "**Services**") in this case:³

- Advise the Company on, and assist the Company in the preparation of, an information memorandum describing the Company and its management and financial status for use in discussions with prospective purchasers and assist in the due diligence process for a potential Sale;
- Assist the Company in developing a list of suitable potential buyers who will be contacted on a discreet and confidential basis after approval by the Company;
- Coordinate the execution of confidentiality agreements for potential buyers wishing to review the information memorandum;
- Assist the Company in coordinating management calls and (where appropriate) site visits for interested buyers and work with the management team to develop appropriate presentations for such calls and visits;
- Solicit competitive offers from potential buyers;
- Advise and assist the Company in structuring the Sale, negotiating the Sale agreements with potential buyers and evaluating the proposals from potential buyers, including, without limitation, advising and negotiating with respect to Sale structures;
- SSG shall assist the Company in the negotiation with various stakeholders in the Company (the "Existing Stakeholders"), including, but not limited to any of the Company's shareholders, lenders, landlords, and general unsecured creditors in regard to a possible Restructuring of existing claims and equity as well as corporate governance.

8. SSG will work with each of the Debtor's professionals to ensure no unnecessary duplication of effort or cost.

PROFESSIONAL COMPENSATION

9. In consideration of the Services, and as more fully described in the Engagement Agreement, subject to the Court's approval, the Debtor has agreed to pay SSG the proposed compensation (the "**Professional Fees and Expenses**") set forth in the Engagement Agreement, which is summarized below:

- Initial Fee. An initial fee (the "Initial Fee") equal to \$50,000 due upon signing the Engagement Agreement. The Initial Fee applies to the first month of the Engagement Term (as such term is hereafter defined);
- Monthly Fees. Monthly fees (the "Monthly Fees") of \$50,000 per month payable beginning in the second month of the Engagement Term, on September 21, 2025 and on the twenty-first (21st) day of each month thereafter throughout the Engagement Term. The Monthly Fee for the month in which the Company files one or more Bankruptcy Cases shall be payable prior to filing.
- Transaction Fee. Upon the consummation of a Sale and/or Restructuring to or with any party, SSG shall be entitled to a fee (the "Transaction Fee"), payable in cash, in federal funds via wire transfer or certified check, at and as a condition of closing such Sale and/or Restructuring and as a direct carveout from proceeds and cash, prior in right to any pre- and post-petition secured debt, equal to the following:
 - a) In the event that a stalking horse purchaser is identified by the Company and its stakeholders prior to SSG's engagement herein, or in the event of a credit bid by the secured creditors, or any of them, without a qualified overbid, then SSG's Transaction Fee shall be \$450,000 and, in that event, SSG's fees shall be capped at \$600,000, inclusive of the Initial Fee, Monthly Fees and Transaction Fee.
 - b) In the event that a qualified overbid is received topping the stalking horse bid and/or credit bid, then SSG's Transaction Fee shall be the greater of (i) \$750,000 or (ii) two (2) percent of Total Consideration (as such term is hereafter defined).
 - c) In the event of a Restructuring with existing stakeholders, SSG's Transaction Fee shall be \$450,000 and, in that event, SSG's fees shall be capped at \$600,000, inclusive of the Initial Fee, Monthly Fees and Transaction Fee.
- For the avoidance of doubt, SSG shall only be paid one Transaction Fee, whichever is greater. Further, the cap on fees shall apply regardless of the duration of the Sale and/or Restructuring process.

10. In addition, and regardless of whether a transaction is consummated, the Debtor will reimburse SSG for all of SSG's reasonable out-of-pocket expenses incurred in connection with the Engagement Agreement.

11. The fee and expense structure described above is comparable to the fees and expenses charged by similar firms for comparable engagements, both in and out of bankruptcy. The fee and expense Structure also is consistent with SSG's normal and customary billing practices for cases of this size and complexity that require the level and scope of services outlined above. SSG and the Debtor believe that the Fee and Expense Structure is reasonable.

12. SSG's strategic and financial expertise, capital markets knowledge, financing skills, restructuring capabilities, and mergers and acquisitions expertise, some or all of which may be required during the term of SSG's engagement, were important factors in negotiating the Fee and Expense Structure.

13. SSG has gained substantial knowledge of the Debtor's business, financial affairs, and creditors since execution of the Engagement Agreement, and SSG is both well qualified and uniquely able to perform these services and assist the Debtor in this chapter 11 Case.

14. SSG has not shared or agreed to share any compensation to be paid by the Debtor with any other person, other than other principals and employees of SSG, in accordance with section 504 of the Bankruptcy Code.

15. Due to SSG's commitment to the variable level of time and effort necessary to address all such issues as they arise, and the market prices for SSG's services for engagements of this nature both and in and out of chapter 11, the Fee and Expense Structure is market-based and fair and reasonable under the standards set forth in section 328(a) of the Bankruptcy Code.

INDEMNIFICATION

16. The Engagement Agreement contains standard indemnification language with respect to SSG's services including, without limitation, an agreement by the Debtor to indemnify SSG and its affiliates, partners, directors, officers, employees and agents (each, an "**Indemnified Party**") and collectively, the "**Indemnified Parties**") from and against all claims, liabilities, losses, expenses and damages arising out of or in connection with the engagement of SSG that is the subject of the Engagement Agreement, except to the extent caused by gross negligence or willful misconduct of any Indemnified Party.

17. SSG believes that the indemnification provisions contained in the Engagement Agreement, as may be amended in the proposed order attached to the Application, are customary and reasonable for SSG and comparable firms providing financial advisory services, and as would be modified pursuant to the foregoing limitations, reflect the qualifications and limitations on indemnification provisions that are customary in this district.

18. Moreover, the terms and conditions of the indemnification provisions were negotiated by the Debtor and SSG at arm's length and in good faith. The provisions contained in the Engagement Agreement, viewed in conjunction with the other terms of SSG's proposed retention, are reasonable and in the best interest of the Debtor, its estate, and all parties in interest in light of the fact that the Debtor requires SSG's services to successfully restructure. Accordingly, as part of the Application, the Debtor requests the Court approve the indemnification provisions as set forth in the Engagement Agreement, as may be amended by the proposed order attached to the Application.

DISINTERESTEDNESS

19. In connection with its proposed retention by the Debtor in this case, SSG undertook to determine whether it had any conflicts or other relationships that might cause it not to be disinterested or to hold or represent an interest adverse to the Debtor. Specifically, SSG obtained from the Debtor's representatives the names of individuals and entities that may be parties in interest in this case (the "**Potential Parties in Interest**"), which are listed on **Schedule 1** attached hereto.

20. SSG has researched its electronic client databases to determine connections with the Potential Parties in Interest. The results of the search of the Potential Parties in Interest are set forth in **Schedule 2** hereto. To the best of SSG's knowledge, neither SSG nor any of its employees: (a) is a creditor or an insider of the Debtor (b) is or was, within two years before the Petition Date, a director, officer, or employee of the Debtor; or (c) has an interest materially adverse to the interest of the Debtor's estate or of any class of creditors, by reason of any direct or indirect relationship in connection with, or interest in, the Debtor, or for any other reason. To the best of SSG's knowledge and belief, SSG has not represented any Potential Parties in Interest in connection with matters relating to the Debtor or their estates, assets, or businesses and will not represent other entities which are creditors of, or have other relationships to, the Debtor in matters relating to this case.

21. In addition, an email was broadly circulated within SSG to inquire whether any employees or partners at SSG, or any member of such recipient's immediate family (spouse, minor children, or family members living in your household): (a) have any connection to the Potential Parties in Interest; (b) own any equity security of the Debtor; (c) own any debt security of the Debtor; (d) hold a general unsecured claim against the Debtor; (e) hold any other claim against the

Debtor; or (f) own more than one percent, manage or otherwise control, or have any influence over any of the Potential Parties in Interest. No affirmative response was received in response to any of these email inquiries.

22. Further, the email inquired whether any recipient of the email (i) has, within the last two (2) years, been an officer, director, or employee of any of the Debtor or (ii) holds an interest materially adverse to interests of the Debtor, or of any class of creditors or equity security holders, by reason of any direct or indirect relationship to, connection with, or interest in, the Debtor, or for any other reason. No affirmative response was received in response to these email inquiries.

23. Moreover, the email inquired whether any recipient is related to (i) any bankruptcy judge for the District of Delaware and/or (ii) any employee of the United States Trustee for Region 3. No affirmative response was received in response to these email inquiries.

24. SSG was retained prepetition and at that time received the Initial Fee upon signing the Engagement Agreement. As of the Petition Date, the Debtor did not owe SSG any fees or expenses incurred before the Petition Date.

25. To the best of my knowledge, as set forth above, no individual assignment in which SSG is involved appeared on the Potential Parties in Interest, and accordingly, none of the entities listed on the Potential Parties in Interest account for more than 10% of SSG's gross revenue during the twelve-month period before to the date hereof.

26. SSG provides investment banking and financial advisory services to a wide variety of clients. As a result, SSG has represented, and may in the future represent, certain Potential Parties in Interest in matters unrelated to the Debtor and this case, either individually or as part of the representation of an ad hoc or official committee of creditors or interest holders. To the best of

SSG's knowledge, information and belief, insofar as SSG has been able to ascertain after reasonable inquiry, none of these representations are adverse to the Debtor's interests.

27. Based on the foregoing, to the best of SSG's knowledge and belief, neither SSG, nor I, nor any other employee of SSG that will provide services to the Debtor in connection with this engagement, has any connection with or holds any interest adverse to the Debtor, its estate, or the Potential Parties in Interest.

28. In addition, SSG has received no revenue in the last two years from any of the Potential Parties in Interest. Further, to the best of SSG's knowledge, there have been no outside business activities or private investments disclosed in SSG's compliance system for any of the Potential Parties in Interest.

29. To the best of SSG's knowledge, information, and belief, insofar as SSG has been able to ascertain after reasonable inquiry, except with respect to the Engagement Agreement, SSG has not been retained to assist any entity or person other than the Debtor on matters relating to, or in direct connection with, this case. SSG will, however, continue to provide professional services to other entities or persons that may be creditors or equity security holders of the Debtor or interested parties in this case; provided that such services do not relate to, or have any direct connection with, this case or the Debtor. Additionally, in connection with its debt capital markets and special situations practices, in the ordinary course of business, SSG has and, may in the future, present investment opportunities to certain of the Potential Parties in Interest.

30. Accordingly, except as otherwise set forth herein, insofar as SSG has been able to determine, neither SSG, nor any employee of SSG holds or represents any interest adverse to the Debtor or its estate, and SSG is a "disinterested person" as that term is defined in Bankruptcy Code section 101(14), as modified by section 1107(b), in that SSG, and its professionals and employees:

- (a) are not creditors, equity security holders or insiders of the Debtor;
- (b) are not and were not, within two years before the date of filing of the Debtor's chapter 11 petition, a director, officer or employee of the Debtor; and
- (c) do not have an interest materially adverse to the interest of the Debtor's estate or any class of creditors or equity security holders, by reason of any direct or indirect relationship to, connection with, or interest in, the Debtor, or for any other reason.

31. To the extent that SSG discovers any additional facts bearing in a material respect on its disinterestedness during the period of SSG's retention in connection with this case, SSG will supplement this Declaration, as required by Bankruptcy Rule 2014(a).

32. Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.
