Owens in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware, 824 North Market Street, Sixth Floor, Court Room 3, Wilmington, Delaware 19801.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that after the Status Conference, counsel for the Lessor and the Debtors conferred with the Court and a hearing on the Motion is scheduled for **September 9, 2026, at 9:30 a.m. (ET)**, before the Honorable Karen B. Owens in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware, 824 North Market Street, Sixth Floor, Court Room 3, Wilmington, Delaware 19801.
