ORDER ESTABLISHING
PROCEDURES FOR INTERIM
PAYMENT OF FEES AND COSTS
TO PROFESSIONALS

THIS MATTER came before the court upon the Motion for Order Establishing Procedures for Interim Payment of Fees and Costs to Professionals (the “Motion”) filed by Brewster Heights Packing & Orchards, LP and its affiliated debtors and debtors-in-possession (collectively, the “Debtors”) in the above-captioned chapter 11 cases (the

1 “Chapter 11 Cases”), pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 105(a), 330, and 331, as well as Federal
2 Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 2016. Capitalized terms in this order have the same
3 meaning identified in the Motion unless otherwise indicated. The court has reviewed the
4 files and records in this case and finds that cause exists for the requested relief. Now,
5 therefore, it is hereby

6 ORDERED as follows:

- 7 1. The Motion is GRANTED;
- 8 2. Each of the professionals retained by the Debtor or any committee appointed
9 pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 1102 whose employment has been duly authorized by the court
10 (collectively, the “Professionals”) shall be authorized to obtain, on a monthly basis,
11 reimbursement for their costs and payment of eighty percent (80%) of their fees ten days
12 after sending a billing statement to the Notified Parties, as that term is defined in the
13 Motion.
14
- 15 3. In the event a party objects to the billing statement of a Professional within
16 ten days of notice, that Professional shall be authorized to seek an order of the court
17 approving payment of its fees and costs on ten days’ notice to the Notified Parties,
18 provided, however, that failure to object to any billing statement of any Professional shall
19 not waive any objection to the fee application of such Professional.
20
- 21 4. The Professionals shall submit fee applications to the court not more than
22 once every one hundred twenty (120) days.
