Caption of Order: Order Granting Chapter 11 Complex Case Designation

After review of the initial pleadings filed in these cases, the Court concludes that these chapter 11 cases meet the eligibility requirements of a Chapter 11 Complex Case under D.N.J. LBR 1002-2, and therefore:

IT IS ORDERED that the request set forth in the *Application for Designation as a Chapter 11 Complex Case* pursuant to the Court's *General Order Governing Chapter 11 Complex Case Procedures* is **HEREBY GRANTED**; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the *Chapter 11 Complex Case Procedures* annexed to the Court's *General Order Governing Chapter 11 Complex Case Procedures* shall apply; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, within ten days from the entry of this Order, the parties are directed to submit to chambers' email a proposed *Case Management Order* utilizing *Local Form Chapter 11 Complex Case Management Order*. The Case Management Order must attach as an exhibit the *General Order* with annexed *Chapter 11 Complex Case Procedures*. Provisions outside the scope of the General Order must be highlighted for the Court's review.
