ORDER AND NOTICE SETTING BAR DATE FOR FILING PROOFS OF CLAIM

**FOR CREDITORS WHO WISH TO FILE CLAIMS AGAINST
THE ABOVE REFERENCED DEBTORS(S);**

1. You are hereby notified that if you wish to file a claim against the Bankruptcy estate of the above referenced Debtor(s) for a debt that arose before the Debtor filed its Bankruptcy case, you must file a Proof of Claim on or before the following applicable date:

(a) Claims of any governmental unit that arose prior to the case filing date must be filed on or before July 28, 2026. (This date must not be earlier than 179 days after the date of the order for relief.)

(b) All other claims that arose prior to the case filing date must be filed on or before June 18, 2026.

2. With respect to preparing and filing proofs of Claim (including any proof of Claim submitted on a Claim Form) proofs of Claim and completed Claim Forms are required to satisfy the following requirements:

- a. Each proof of Claim shall conform substantially to Official Bankruptcy Form No. 410;
- b. Each proof of Claim must (i) be written in English (ii) include a Claim amount denominated in United States dollars (and to the extent such Claim is converted to United States dollars the conversion rate used in such conversion) and (iii) be signed by the holder of the Claim or by an authorized agent of the holder of the Claim;
- c. Each proof of Claim must include supporting documentation in accordance with Bankruptcy Rules 3001 (c) and 3001 (d);
- d. Each Proof of Claim may be filed with Stretto no later than 11:59 p. m. prevailing Central Time on the applicable deadline as set forth above in paragraphs 1(a) and 1(b) as applicable in the following manner:

All claims may be filed electronically or at the following address so that they are received on or before the expiration of the bar date listed above:

Additionally, Proofs of Claim may be filed or submitted electronically using the interface available on the Stretto website at <https://cases.stretto.com/IntegrityInvestmentREO/file-a-claim/>. Proof of Claim Forms submitted to Stretto by facsimile or email will not be accepted. If any creditor asserting a claim mails their Proof of Claim to Stretto for filing such creditor must mail early enough so that Stretto actually receives it on or before the applicable Bar Date as stated above as the deadline in paragraphs 1(a) and 1(b) as applicable.

e. Additionally and notwithstanding anything else on this Order and Notice to the contrary any holder of a Claim may file a signed proof of Claim against the Debtor on a form substantially similar to Official Form B 410 electronically or by mail with the Clerk of the US Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Illinois Eastern Division at 219 S. Dearborn Street Chicago IL 60604.

f. If you fail to file a timely claim, your claim may not be allowed, and you may also be barred from voting on a proposed Plan of Reorganization and from receiving any distribution from the Debtor's Bankruptcy estate.

h. Under the law some parties need not file claims. See 11 U.S.C. § 1111(a) for a description of who does not need to file a claim. Parties must rely on their own inspection of the Bankruptcy Code and Rules and the Debtor's schedules or advice of counsel to determine whether to file a claim.

i. Stretto shall mail the applicable notices on or before April 5, 2026.
