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**CONSENT BRIDGE ORDER RELATING TO THE DEBTORS' EXCLUSIVE PERIOD
TO FILE A PLAN AND SOLICIT ACCEPTANCES THEREOF AND USE OF
CASH COLLATERAL PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C. § 361 AND 363 AND
CONTINUATION OF HEARING ON MATTERS SCHEDULED FOR JUNE 30, 2026**

AND NOW, this 22nd day of June 2026, upon the consent of Whitehall Manor, Inc., Saucon Valley Manor, Inc., Whitehall Trust, Saucon Trust Lehigh Valley 1, LLC, and Erin Duffy, Esq. as prepetition receiver, and with no objection from the Office of the United States Trustee, it is hereby ORDERED that:

1. Debtors Whitehall Manor, Inc. and Saucon Valley Manor, Inc. are hereby authorized to continue to use Cash Collateral on the same terms and in the same amounts as set forth in the Sixth Interim Cash Collateral Order, entered on May 29, 2026 [Docket No. 168], the terms of which shall remain in effect, for the limited period through and including July 31, 2026.

2. The exclusive periods during which the Debtors, including Whitehall Trust and Saucon Trust to the extent that they are determined to be eligible to seek Chapter 11 relief, may file a Chapter 11 plan and solicit acceptances thereof are extended through and including July 31, 2026.

3. All matters scheduled to be heard by the Court in these cases on June 30, 2026 are hereby continued to be heard on July 22, 2026, at 2:00 p.m. at the Robert N.C. Nix, Sr. Federal
