**ORDER ON SECOND INTERIM APPLICATION FOR ALLOWANCE OF
COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES INCURRED BY
GREENBERG TRAURIG, LLP, COUNSEL TO THE DEBTORS, FOR
THE PERIOD OF NOVEMBER 1, 2025 THROUGH FEBRUARY 28, 2026**

Upon consideration of the *Second Interim Application for Allowance of Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses Incurred by Greenberg Traurig, LLP, Counsel to the Debtors, for the*

Period of November 1, 2025 Through February 28, 2026 (the “Application”),² for (a) allowance of reasonable compensation for professional services rendered by Greenberg Traurig, LLP (“GT”) to the Debtors for the period from November 1, 2025 through February 28, 2026 (the “Application Period”), and (b) reimbursement of actual and necessary charges and disbursements incurred by GT in the rendition of required professional services on behalf of the Debtors during the Application Period; and due and sufficient notice of the Application and (i) the opportunity to object to the relief requested in the Application by April 23, 2026 (the “Objection Deadline”) and (ii) the hearing on the Application scheduled for May 6, 2026 at 10:15 a.m. (prevailing Eastern Time) having been given under the particular circumstances pursuant to the Fifth Amended and Restated General Order No. 24-2018; and only *The Labor Plaintiffs’ Limited Objection to Debtors’ Second Interim Application for Allowance of Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses Incurred by Greenberg Traurig, LLP, Counsel for the Debtors, for the Period from November 1, 2025 Through February 28, 2026* [Docket No. 368] (the “Limited Response”) having been filed prior to the Objection Deadline by the Labor Plaintiffs (as such term is defined in the Limited Response), reserving their rights with respect to GT’s final allowance of compensation; and good and sufficient cause appearing therefore; it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

1. The Application [Docket No. 365] is hereby granted in its entirety.
2. An interim allowance shall be made to GT in the sum of **\$500,713.00** as compensation for necessary and reasonable professional services rendered during the Application Period and the sum of **\$767.36** for reimbursement of actual and necessary costs and expenses incurred during the Application Period.

3. GT is authorized to apply against such amounts the amounts that have been and,

subsequent to the Application, were paid to it by the Debtors in respect of the Application Period pursuant to the Complex Case Procedures.

4. The terms and conditions of this Order shall be immediately effective and enforceable upon its entry.

5. The Debtors are authorized and empowered to take all actions necessary to implement the relief granted in this Order.

6. Notice of the Application as provided therein shall be deemed good and sufficient notice of such Application and the requirements of Bankruptcy Rule 6004(a), the Local Rules, and the Complex Case Procedures are satisfied by such notice.

7. The Court retains exclusive jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the implementation, interpretation, or enforcement of this Order.

8. Counsel for the Debtors, through Kurtzman Carson Consultants, LLC d/b/a Verita Global (“Verita”) shall, within three (3) days of the entry of this Order, cause a copy of this Order to be served by electronic mail or first class mail, as applicable, on all parties served with the Application, and Verita shall file promptly thereafter a certificate of service confirming such service.
