ORDER

AND NOW, this 28th day of May, 2026, for the reasons stated at the hearing held this date on the *Expedited Motion of the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors to Compel Debtor's Compliance with the Court's May 4, 2026 Order* (Doc. 256) and *Debtor's Response to Expedited Motion of the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors to Compel Compliance with the Court's May 4, 2026 Order* (Doc. 276), it is hereby **ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED** that the *Motion* is **GRANTED** as follows:

1. **On or before June 5, 2026**, the Parties shall file with the Court their Confidentiality Agreement on Discovery as a Proposed Consent Order.
2. The Parties shall immediately cooperate to engage a third-party custodian and agree on ESI discovery protocols including the utilization of search terms by the custodian. Once a protocol is in place, additional searches may be done for documents responsive to the Priority Discovery Requests, and shall be done specifically as to Requests 3, 4, 5, 7(a), 7(b), 7(c), 7(d) and 7(e) of the Priority Discovery Requests.

3. **On or before June 10, 2026**, the Debtor shall provide additional responsive documents to the Priority Discovery Requests as follows:

- a. Request 1: The Debtor shall provide to Counsel for the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors (“Committee”) a declaration authored and executed by Fulton Bank that fully represents the terms of the pass-through Debtor in Possession Financing Agreement.
- b. Request 1(a): The Debtor, in the event it has not already done so, shall provide “[a] fully linked (dynamic) DIP budget and 13-week cash flow forecast model in Excel, including all supporting schedules and assumptions, all historical versions of DIP budgets, forecasts, and variance reports, and all analyses, models, presentations, and materials supporting the size, structure, pricing, and timing of the DIP facility, any consideration of alternative financing amounts or sources, and any comparisons to third-party DIP financing proposals.”
- c. Request 2: The Debtor shall provide to the Committee any portion of the Pledge and Security Agreement dated October 17, 2023 relating to Crown Boiler, Inc. as well as all documents relating to the statement in Paragraph 15 of the *Affidavit of Nick Ribich in Support of Complex Chapter 11 Designation and First Day Motions* (Doc. 50). **On or before June 5, 2026, the Debtor shall provide Chambers with a copy of the complete Pledge and Security Agreement for *in camera* review.**

- d. Request 6: The Debtor shall provide a privilege log that sets forth the information it seeks to protect.
- e. Request 7(b): **On or before June 5, 2026, the Debtor shall provide responsive documents to Chambers for *in camera* review.**
- f. Request 7(c): The Debtor shall provide the Committee with all documents related to available insurance net of exhausted policies or insolvent insurers, including schedules of remaining limits, loss-run reports, exhaustion analyses by policy year and layer, coverage charts, and all documents relating to exhaustion of primary and excess policies. BHI is not required to produce any documents that include settlement analysis, settlement history and/or payment on an individual claim basis to the extent that it would disclose internal claim valuation.
- g. Request 7(d): The Debtor shall provide to the Committee any additional insurance policies available or potentially available to the asbestos claimants of Crown Boiler, Inc.
- h. Request 10: Request 10 shall be treated as continuing discovery request and the Debtor shall produce the requested documents to the Committee if and when any responsive materials become available.

4. On or before June 10, 2026, the Committee shall provide documents responsive, or a privilege log, if applicable, to the Debtor's May 15, 2026 request of:

All communications, by email, text, or any other electronic or recorded means, from the petition date of February 25, 2026, to the date of production of these documents between the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors ("Committee"), their counsel, their financial advisors and any other professional on the one hand, and with any of the Committee members, including Michael Sabatino, James J. Williams, Jr. and Mary Lou Petit, Personal Representative of the Estate of Randall K. Pettit, their counsel, including Weitz & Luxembourg, P.C., Meirowitz & Wassberg, LLP or any of their other professionals on the other hand.
