NOTICE OF JULY 8, 2026 HEARING

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Texas (the “**Court**”) has scheduled a hearing for **July 8, 2026 at 9:00 a.m. (Prevailing Central Time)** (the “**Hearing**”) before the Honorable Christopher M. Lopez, United States Bankruptcy Judge for the Southern District of Texas, Houston Division and that the following motion previously filed by the above-captioned debtors and debtors-in-possession (collectively, the “**Debtors**”), will be heard on a final basis at the Hearing:

1. *Emergency Motion of Debtors for Entry of Interim and Final Orders (I) Authorizing the Debtors to Use Cash Collateral, (II) Granting Adequate Protection, (III) Confirming Application of the Automatic Stay, (IV) Scheduling a Final Hearing on the Motion, and (V) Granting Related Relief* [Docket No. 24].

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that any written responses or objections to the relief requested in the above listed motion shall be filed with the Court no later than **5:00 p.m. (Prevailing Central Time) on July 2, 2026**.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the Hearing will take place in Courtroom 402 of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Texas, 515 Rusk Street, Houston Texas 77002.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that counsel and other parties in interest may participate in person or virtually with counsel appearing remotely through the Court’s audio and video conference systems.
