**NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF
OBJECTION OF FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY AND
CONSOLIDATED EDISON COMPANY OF NEW YORK, INC. TO THE EMERGENCY
MOTION OF DEBTOR FOR ENTRY OF INTERIM AND FINAL ORDERS (I)
APPROVING DEBTOR'S PROPOSED FORM OF ADEQUATE ASSURANCE OF
PAYMENT, (II) ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR RESOLVING OBJECTIONS
AND REQUESTS FOR ADDITIONAL ASSURANCE FROM UTILITY COMPANIES,
(III) PROHIBITING UTILITY COMPANIES FROM ALTERING, REFUSING, OR
DISCONTINUING SERVICE, AND (IV) GRANTING RELATED RELIEF**

Florida Power & Light Company and Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (collectively, the "Utilities"), by counsel, hereby withdraw their *Objection* (ECF No. 72) to the *Emergency Motion of Debtor For Entry of Interim and Final Orders (I) Approving Debtor's Proposed Form of Adequate Assurance of Payment, (II) Establishing Procedures For Resolving Objections and Requests For Additional Assurance From Utility Companies, (III) Prohibiting Utility Companies From Altering, Refusing, or Discontinuing Service, and (IV) Granting Related Relief* (ECF No. 16), pursuant to a settlement between the Utilities and the Debtor that the Debtor will announce on the record.
