This matter came before the Court on McDonald Carano LLP's ("McDonald Carano") *Application for Order Authorizing the Retention and Employment of McDonald Carano LLP as Co-Counsel for the Debtor In Possession* ("Application"). Appearances at the hearing were as noted on the record.

By its Application, McDonald Carano requested approval of this Court to represent the Debtor Navellier & Associated, Inc. ("Debtor") as bankruptcy co-counsel in connection with the above-captioned chapter 11 case (the "Chapter 11 Case"), and further requested that this Court enter

1 an order pursuant to §§ 327(a) and 330 of Title 11 of the United States Code, 11 U.S.C. §§ 101 *et*
 2 *seq.*, Rule 2014(a) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, and Rule 2014 of the Local
 3 Bankruptcy Rules for the District of Nevada authorizing it to provide the legal services described
 4 in the Application.

5 The Application having been properly noticed and no objections having been filed to the
 6 Application, the Court considered the papers and pleadings on file in this case and the oral
 7 presentation of counsel at the hearing, With the Court having stating its oral findings of fact and
 8 conclusions of law on the record, all of which are incorporated herein pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P.
 9 7052 and 9014, and with good cause appearing, the Court enters its Order as follows.

10 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Application is granted, and, effective as of the date of
 11 the filing the Application, the Debtor is authorized pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 327(a) to employ
 12 McDonald Carano as Debtor's general bankruptcy co-counsel in this Chapter 11 Case pursuant to
 13 the terms and conditions set forth in the Application, with McDonald Carano's compensation subject
 14 to subsequent approval by this Court pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 330 and 331.

15 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that co-counsel are to use their best efforts not to duplicate
 16 the services they provide on behalf of the Debtor.

17 **IT IS SO ORDERED.**
